Sources of Electricity Supplied for the 12 months ending 6/30/2026

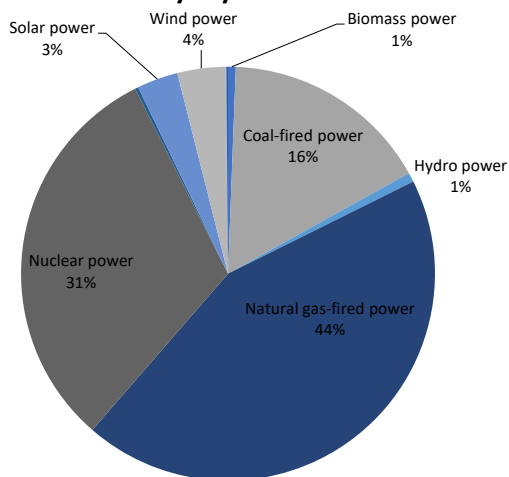
